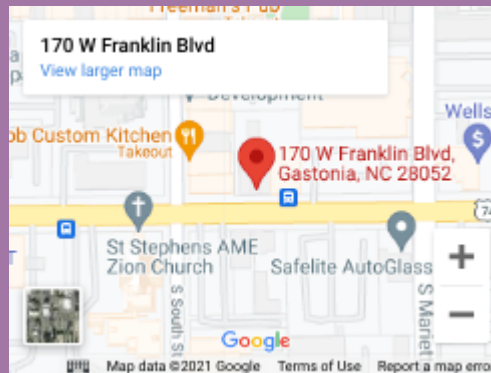

AVAILABLE SERVICES

SAFETY PLANNING- DEVELOP AN INDIVIDUALIZED COMPREHENSIVE PLAN TO INCREASE SAFETY.

SHELTER PLACEMENT- ASSISTANCE ACCESSING A CONFIDENTIAL SAFE SHELTER.

EMERGENCY PROTECTIVE ORDERS- ASSISTANCE CONNECTING TO ADVOCATES TO FILE CIVIL ACTIONS TO REQUEST A STAY AWAY/PROTECTION ORDER (50B).

ADULT SUPPORT AND GUIDANCE- INFORMATION AND ASSISTANCE WITH ACCESSING RESOURCES AND HELP NAVIGATING THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM.

CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION- MEET WITH LAW ENFORCEMENT ABOUT POSSIBLE CRIMINAL CHARGES, DISCUSS A PENDING CASE, AND LEARN ABOUT THE COURT PROCESS.

LEGAL SERVICES- ASSISTANCE WITH YOUR CIVIL AND/OR CRIMINAL CASE WHILE HELPING YOU NAVIGATE THE JUDICIAL SYSTEM.

EMERGENCY NEEDS AND SHELTER- CONNECT TO RESOURCES TO ASSIST IN SUPPLYING FOOD, SHELTER, AND CLOTHING.

EMPLOYMENT AND FINANCIAL SUPPORT- INFORMATION AND REFERRALS TO COMMUNITY SERVICES INCLUDING EMPLOYMENT ASSISTANCE, HELP WITH FOOD STAMPS, VICTIM COMPENSATION, AND OTHER PUBLIC ASSISTANCE.

EMOTIONAL SUPPORT AND MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES- TALK WITH STAFF ABOUT AVAILABLE RESOURCES FOR INDIVIDUAL OR GROUP COUNSELING.

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I need an appointment?
Yes. Appointments are preferred to ensure adequate time for each individual situation.

May I bring my children with me?

Yes. Childcare assistance provided. (Please inform our staff if childcare is needed)

Does Hope United Survivor Network charge for their services?

No. Our services are free.

May I bring a friend for support?

Yes. However, when you speak with one of the professional staff, your friend may be asked to wait in the reception area.

Where can I park?

Free parking is available in the back parking lot located off S. South Street.
